Training Programme

Nutrition and Well-being

Introduces some of the principles of good nutrition and some of the different food requirements associated with different cultural backgrounds.

Safeguarding and Protection in Health and Social Care

This course will help you to recognise abuse and what you can do to safeguard and protect vulnerable adults.

Supporting adults with epilepsy and learning disability and the administration of buccal midazolam

This six hour course aims to update and increase participants' understanding of the epilepsies, provides a purposeful insight into the support needs of adults with learning disability and epilepsy and teaches the safe administration of buccal midazolam

Medication

Discusses issues that may arise such as, storing medication insecurely, storing medicines at the wrong temperature, individuals receiving the wrong medication and inappropriate handling of medication by untrained staff.

Fire Awareness

This course will take you through the requirements of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order of 2005.

First Aid

This course will take you through what First Aid really means - which is giving someone immediate or initial assistance until qualified medical assistance arrives.

Safe Food Hygiene

This course will take you through the various stages of food handling and highlight areas which will be critical to food safety.

Health and Safety

This course is designed to help you understand the principles of workplace health and safety.

Customer Care

Describes and outlines good practice when working with customers and demonstrates a person-centred approach to customer care.

Supporting People with Dementia

Provides an understanding of dementia and offers practical advice.

Deprivation of Liberty

Aims to explain deprivation of liberty, the Act and policies in place to help prevent it from occurring, and how staff can help to empower a person and protect their liberty.

Mental Capacity Act

Explains what the Mental Capacity Act is, who it affects, and how mental capacity affects the decision-making process.

Care Planning

Teaches what a Care Plan is, why Care Plans are needed, and how to maintain a Care Plan in accordance with the National Minimum Standards.

Managing Violence and Aggression

An in-depth look at factors that lead to violence and aggression, how violence and aggression are manifested, and techniques and strategies that can help to eliminate or minimise the consequences.

Moving and Positioning

This course teaches the fundamental principles of physical movement and manual positioning of a person, how injuries are caused, the Work Acts and procedures in place to help prevent injury, and how to safely perform moving and positioning tasks.

Infection Control

Instructs the learner on the dangers and hazards associated with infection, the need for infection control, and how to prevent infection.

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
